RE: FRIENDS OF WARRINGAH RUGBY FOUNDATION – 2023 ANNUAL NEWSLETTER

I am writing to you to update you on the progress of the Friends of Warringah Rugby Foundation ("FOWRF") for the 2023 year.

Before I do this, I would like to thank you for your membership of the FOWRF. Your membership of the FOWRF is highly valued and your annual financial contribution helps contribute to the ongoing success of the Rats.

There were some mixed results across the Club in 2023 with Grade struggling and Colts minor premiers in all three grades and winning the Colts Club Championship. Congratulations to all those involved in Colts in 2023. Despite these mixed results, it seems like the Rats are in a good position to continue to be a force in the Shute Shield.

Friends of Warringah Rugby Foundation Limited

As you are aware, the FOWRF was reformed in mid-2010. As of October 2023, we have over 50 contributors (the names of each of the FOWRF contributors can be found on the FOWRF website – www.friendsofwarringah.com). As a reminder:

- > The assets of the FOWRF are kept separate from those of the WRC;
- The decision as to the expenditure of the contributions is made independently by the FOWRF Committee and,
- All FOWRF members are welcome to review the financial records, attend any Committee meetings or provide any input or suggestions for future projects or fundraising activities.

The Friends of Warringah Rugby Foundation Limited ACN 119 353 650 (the "Foundation") is established as a fundraising partner of the Australian Sports Foundation ("ASF").

The Foundation is registered with and conducted under the charter of the ASF. The ASF was established by the Australian Government to raise funds through public and corporate donations for the development of sport in Australia. The ASF's listing in the Income Tax Assessment Act (1977) means donations of \$2 or more are tax deductible. Registration with the ASF allows donations to the ASF in support of the Foundation to attract tax deduction.

What has your FOWRF membership contributed in 2023?

The major expenditure for 2023 has been as follows:

- Funded the Rats History Documentary which premiered to rave reviews at the Warriewood Cinema in March 2023;
- Contributed to the cost of rugby/personal development for the First Grade Coach and Captain to visit the Melbourne Storm training;
- Contributed to the upgrade and maintenance of the Rats gym;



- Made a significant contribution to the Rats Rising Program;
- ▶ Funded the reintroduction of the newsletter "Rats Tales"; and
- > Financial assistance to relocate some of the interstate and overseas players.

It is our continued intention to prioritise our projects in accordance with what we see as providing the most benefit to WRC across the spectrum from Schools to Juniors to Colts to Grade. We will be happy to receive your suggestions for consideration.

Rats History Documentary

The FOWRF was proud to fund the production of the 90 minute Rats History Documentary. The filming first started in 2017 and was finally completed in late 2022. The premiere was held at Warriewood Cinema in March 2023 with just under 300 attending.

The FOWRF hopes the documentary correctly reflects the evolution of the Club and provides an important record of some of the key people involved over the first 50 years of the Club.



2023 FOWRF Player of the Year

The 2023 FOWRF Player of the Year winner was shared by First Grade players, Wes Thomas and Andrew Davies. The FOWRF members voted for 12 different individual players which illustrates the wide range of opinions.





A comment from a FOWRF member on each was as follows:
